

### Background

Residents state that they disliked the impact of fly-tipping on their environment and reported occurrences quickly. People were uncertain about who was responsible for removal.

- Fly tipping is an ongoing issue for the area.
- Frequently fly tipping occurs near to the perpetrators' own homes.
- Private land owners are responsible for the waste tipped on to their land.
- Some locations are used repeatedly.
- Some waste is toxic and needs special equipment to remove.
- There is a cost of around £25 to clear each small deposit in an accessible location.
- Village residents report occurrences quickly.

- Aim to clear from Surrey County Council Highways and Borough Council land within 5-7 days.
