A separate form **MUST** be completed for each child who is competing in the Games.

■ **Emergency Contact Details**

Parents are strongly advised to give a telephone number or numbers at which they may be contacted in case of an emergency, in particular when urgent medical or dental treatment may be deemed necessary by a qualified medical doctor or dentist. Parents who are willing to allow emergency medical or dental treatment to be given to their children when necessary should sign their consent. In all cases the Event Organisers and the Borough Team Organisers will ensure that every reasonable effort is made to contact parents in an emergency.

■ **Medical Information/Special Requirements**

Parents should inform the coach or Borough Team Organiser of any injury, illness, allergies (including suncream etc) or medical condition(s), as well as any special requirements their child may have.

Completed Parental Consent Forms should be returned to Team Managers and should be carried by the Team Manager and Borough Team Organiser on the day of the event in case of emergency. This will be the responsibility of the Borough, not The Active Surrey Sports Partnership.

Parents should ensure that competitors carry any required medication with them.

■ **Photography**

Due to increased concern an entry on the form concerns the publishing of photographs and video footage of children. Boroughs must compile a list of any competitors that **DO NOT** wish their picture to be taken and forward this list onto Active Surrey by the Monday prior to the event. A list will be produced to ensure that official photographers do not take any pictures of these children.

Competitors may also be able to purchase photos from the photographer's website. If this is the case, the website will be password protected to ensure that only competitors and their families can view the photos.

I do **NOT** give my consent for photos or video footage of my child to be taken whilst they are taking part in the P&G Surrey Youth Games. I realise that this means that the whole of their team (including team photos) will not be able to be photographed.
