

■ Background

- This was an issue reported by residents through Residents Association meetings, interviews and their questionnaire responses.
 - Dog walkers use the Village Greens to exercise their animals.
 - Children play on the Village Greens.
 - Residents say they do not have sufficient places to put dog excreta. Residents believe that any disincentive results in some people not collecting excreta.

■ Location(s)

- Netherne on the Hill Village Green.

■ Action

- Allocate more dog excreta bins.
Responsibility: MainStay Residential Management Services

■ Resource

- Provision of bins.

■ Timescale

- 2005/06.

■ Outcome measure/reporting

- Bins provided.

■ Local Community: what you can do

- Stop your dog fouling in a public place.
 - Use bins once they are provided, take dog excreta home until then.
 - Dog waste can be put in normal rubbish bins when wrapped.
