1. Cockshott Hill	Potholes	Currently being resurfaced.
2. New Causeway	Potholes	In a rolling programme but low priority.
3. Park Lane East	Potholes	Inspected potholes will be repaired in due course.
4. Prices Lane	Potholes	High priority - submitted for funding next year to resurface entire length.
5. Sancross Lane	Potholes	High priority - submitted for funding next year to resurface entire length.
Minor Roads		
6. Barons Road	Potholes	Completed.
7. Blackthorne Road	Dips since the road was resurfaced	No significant depressions found. To be monitored.
8. Castle Drive	Potholes	Inspected potholes will be repaired in due course.
9. Clayhall Lane	Potholes	Inspected potholes will be repaired in due course.
10. Hartswood Avenue	Potholes	Inspected potholes will be repaired in due course.
11. Hazel Road	The road is sinking at the end	There is a slight depression in the road but not considered significant at present. To be monitored.
12. Hitchings Way	Potholes	In a rolling programme as a medium priority.
13. Holly Road	Dips since the road was resurfaced	No significant depressions found. To be monitored.
14. Linkfield Street	Very uneven surface	In a rolling programme as a medium priority.
15. Meadow Way	The verges are being destroyed by cars parking on them	In general, the condition of the verge in Meadow Way is satisfactory.
16. South Road	Trench needs filling	Completed.
17. Trentham Road	Potholes	Inspected in January 2005. Road in poor condition. Pothole repairs will be carried out and the road will be monitored.
18. Trumpets Hill Road	Potholes	Potholes 50-80 yards from the boundary will be filled shortly.
19. Waterlow Road	Potholes	Completed.
20. West Street	Poor condition	Inspected in January 2005. The building site in the local vicinity generates large quantities of mud on the road.
General		
21. Potholes are repaired but the remedial works are relatively short term and further repair work is needed within 6 months.		Surrey County Council Highways have an inspection regime to ensure the quality of works. Sometimes, the defect requires an initial temporary repair to make the surface safe before a more permanent repair is carried out
22. At the traffic lights near the hospital, a drain is sticking up in the middle of the road.		The contractor will repair this shortly.
