

■ Background

- The traders would like to make use of the clock currently outside the pharmacy.
- ‘The Village Jewellers’ are prepared to maintain the clock annually, servicing it and maintaining the parts as necessary. They are also willing to provide electricity subject to their name appearing on one of the panels.
- Refurbishment, servicing and fitting costs to bring the clock back into use is estimated at £1500-£1800.
