HMP Project Focus



Background

- The HMP seeks to promote more sustainable forms of transport, such as walking, cycling and public transport
- Improving bus services forms an important part of this strategy
- Investment is being put into enhancing passenger facilities and running bus services
- In 2005, partners introduced the Fastway 20 service to replace the old 200
- The launch was accompanied by improvements to passenger facilities along the bus route

Key benefits

- **Provides a direct link** between the Acres – Horley Town Centre – Gatwick – Three Bridges – Broadfield
- **Frequent weekday services** running every 20 minutes (30 minutes previously)
- **Sunday and evening services introduced** where there were none previously
- **Early morning services introduced** everyday from Horley to Gatwick for those with early flights or early shifts.
- **A high quality fleet** that provide increased passenger comfort and that have low emissions
- **Wi-Fi** connectivity available on buses
- **Improved transport information** through smart phone apps, the internet and QR scans
- **Bus patronage** has increased with 38% more passengers using the service in Horley between 2010 and 2013.
