



Background

- The HMP seeks to improve the recreational and leisure facilities in the town for local people
- A key part of this was to provide a new leisure centre to replace the old Horley Anderson
- In 2011, the Borough Council opened the new £9m Horley leisure centre, which includes:
 - o A 25 metre swimming pool with six lanes
 - o A teaching pool for youngsters and beginners
 - o A fitness gym with exercise stations and free weights
 - o A multi-use purpose hall got sports such as badminton and table tennis
 - A dance and exercise studio for group exercise

Key benefits

- Provision of high quality modern facilities for leisure centre users
- Facilities are fully accessible for disabled people with specialist equipment such as a ramp, a hoist, braille signage and induction loop
- The centre uses sustainable building technology such as biomass, photovoltaic panels and natural light/ventilation, to cut running costs and reduce carbon
- The centre has been highly popular with a 143% increase in the number of average monthly users between 2011 and 2013
