THE TADWORTH FORUM

1. The Forum's Email address is chapmanandsonbutchers@hotmail.co.uk
2. The Forum is in the process of setting up a Forum Website (including sections on the business and retail sectors, the village, the churches, local history, local charities, local sport and activities). Jim Allen in Burpham Surrey, who has done a comprehensive website for the Burpham Neighbourhood Forum ("BNF"), has offered to help as have various local experts on web site design.
3. The Forum is liaising with local residents groups in the area including Woodmansterne and Burgh Heath and neighbourhood fora/Parish Councils affected in the Mole Valley and Guildford area by large housing targets often on greenfield or green belt sites.
4. Chris Chapman is holding a Tadworth Business and Retail Forum meeting with all 3 Parades and local businesses in the week beginning 9th March. They have already been circulated with letters about the Neighbourhood Forum and the forthcoming Neighbourhood Plan and been asked to participate.

The same applies to the two schools in Tadworth and Heathcote Medical Centre. In addition, notices have been posted on the 2 local notice boards and in Chapman & Son's shop window.

It is assumed that Councillor Rachael Turner will continue to be involved as a Local Councillor and a representative of The Childrens' Trust.

4. The Reverend Michael Alfred has offered the Forum use of the Church and/or the Church Hall for formal meetings of the Forum.
5. There is a meeting on Monday pm 2nd March with Planning Policy where we should like to finalise the Area, the Forum's Constitution and the List of the Forum Members (see below). Clearly the Forum want to ensure that Reigate & Banstead Borough Council ("RBBC") is in a position to commence the 6 week public consultation period then while the Forum continues consulting locally and drafting its Neighbourhood Plan.

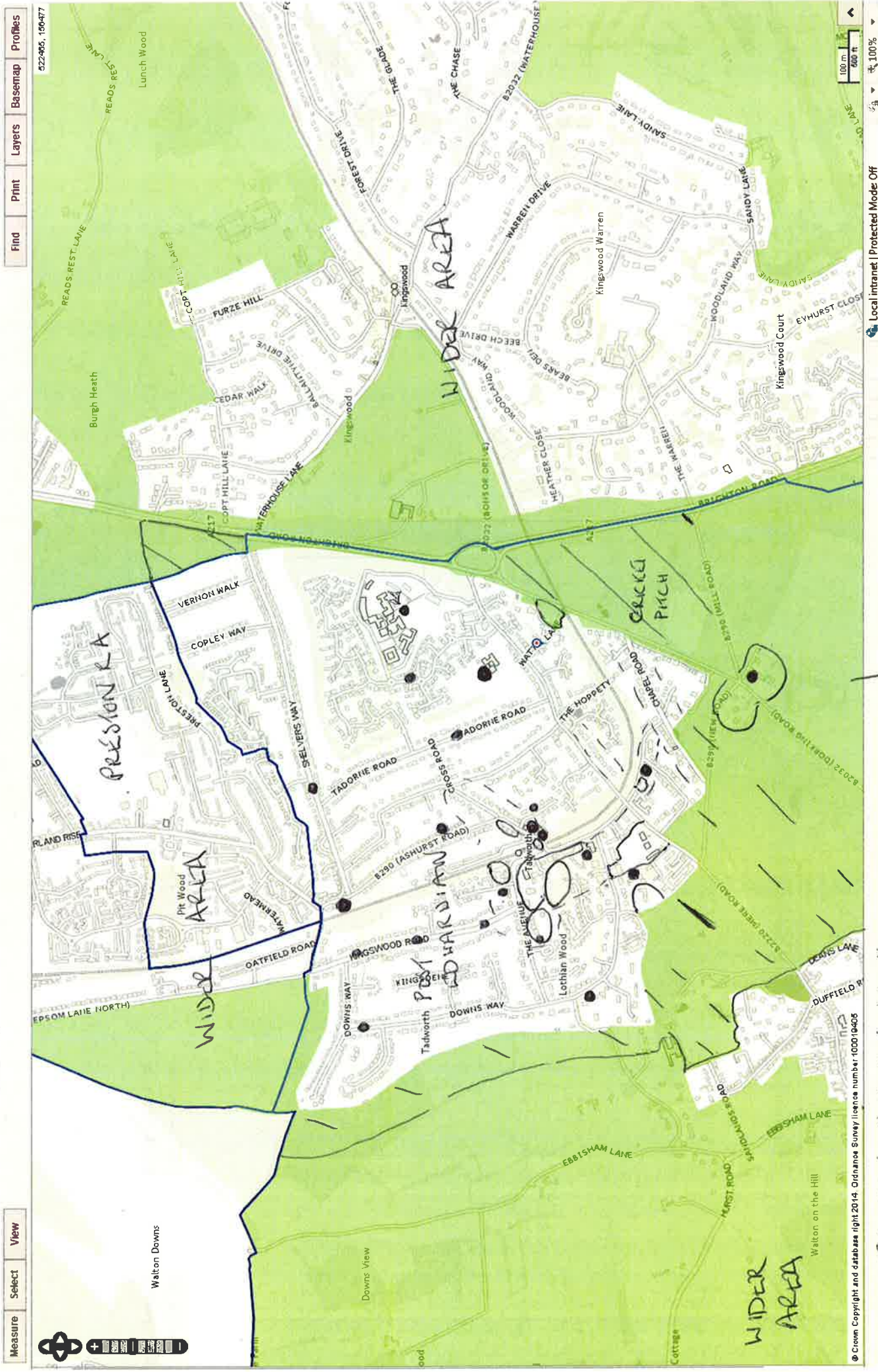
