

Timetable for the UK Parliamentary general election on 8 June 2017

Please be aware that the timetable may change in the event of days being appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning. This timetable is based on the assumption that the writ is received on the day following the dissolution of Parliament.

Event	Date (deadline if not midnight)
Dissolution of Parliament	Wednesday 3 May
Receipt of writ	Thursday 4 May
Publication of notice of election	Not later than 4pm on Monday 8 May
Deadline for delivery of nomination papers	4pm on Thursday 11 May
Publication of statement of persons nominated, including notice of poll and situation of polling stations	If no objections: at 5pm on Thursday 11 May
Deadline for receiving applications for registration	Monday 22 May
Deadline for receiving new postal vote and postal proxy applications, and for changes to existing postal or proxy votes	5pm on Tuesday 23 May
Deadline for receiving new applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy or emergency proxies)	5pm on Wednesday 31 May
First date that electors can apply for a replacement for lost postal votes	Friday 2 June
Polling day	7am to 10pm on Thursday 8 June
Last time for re-issue of spoilt or lost postal votes	5pm on Thursday 8 June
Deadline for emergency proxy applications	5pm on Thursday 8 June
Last time to alter the register due to clerical error or court appeal	9pm on Thursday 8 June
