Urgency reasons

The Council has an opportunity to bid for the delivery of the revenue and benefits service for Horsham District Council.

Horsham District Council will be meeting on 25 May to consider the awarding of the contract, and have indicated that they would require an in principle agreement from the Executive, ahead of that meeting, to be able to take into consideration any bid made by this authority.

In the circumstances the Executive is requested to consider this matter urgently in the event that the Council is successful in the bidding process.

The reason that the items are likely to be considered in private is that they will involve the disclosure of exempt information as defined in schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972, namely the financial or business affairs of the Council.
