

## Hostels and night shelters

This document provides details of hostels and night shelters which are in or close to the borough of Reigate and Banstead.

- The following hostels may have rooms available on a 'direct access' basis. This means that you can contact them yourself on the day that you are homeless and try to book a room for that night.
- If you get a room in a hostel, you may be able to stay there for up to 4 weeks.
- You will have to show identification when presenting at the hostel.
- If certain circumstances, the Council is able to refer you to hostels.

- For vulnerable single women aged 16-39
- 17 single rooms, 3 of which are adapted for people with disabilities and 2 rooms for 2 people sharing
- 24 hour staff support
- Self-referrals accepted, phone for an application
- Will accept applicants with drug, alcohol or mental health problems who are committed to treatment
- Will not accept applicants with history of extreme violence to others
- Maximum stay 2 years
- Operates a waiting list
