

Council Tax 2017/18

How your money helps fund the services Reigate & Banstead Borough Council provides

For Reigate & Banstead Borough Council's services, an average household pays just **£214.44 a year, which equates to £4.12 a week***.

This year, our share of your Council Tax bill increased by 2.39% - that's less than 10 pence per week for a Band D household*.

This rise is vital if we are to continue to deliver quality services to our 144,000 residents to ensure that the borough is a great place to live and work.

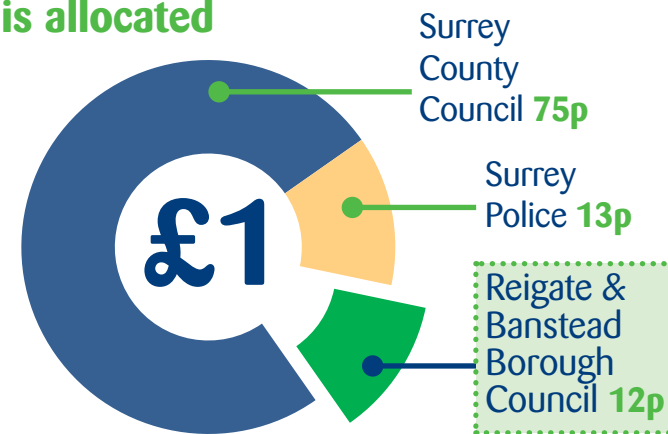
Our government grant, which helps to fund our services, ends in April. This means that it will increasingly fall to the council to find new sources

of income and to residents to pay for local services.

We have prepared for this and will be financially self-sufficient by then. We now generate over £13.6 million in income, including £2.5 million from our property and assets. This helps to keep the increase in our 12% share of your council tax bill to a minimum.

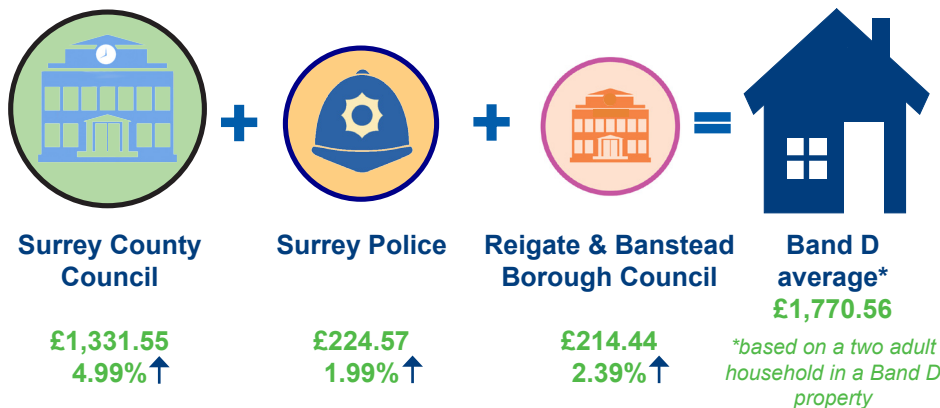

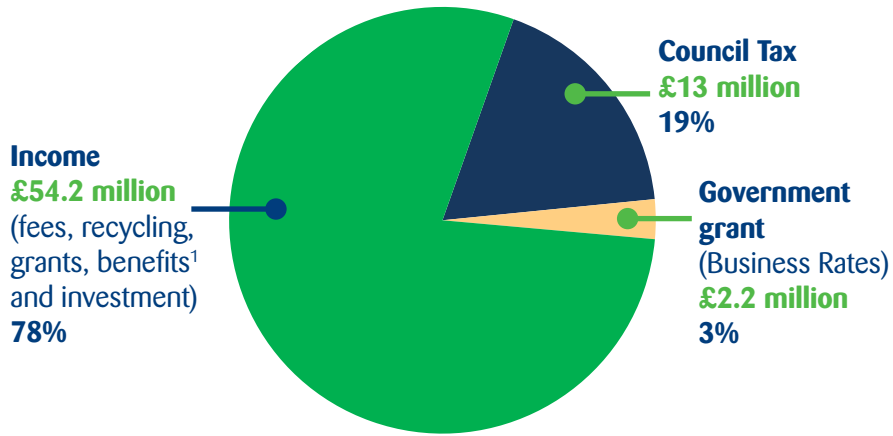

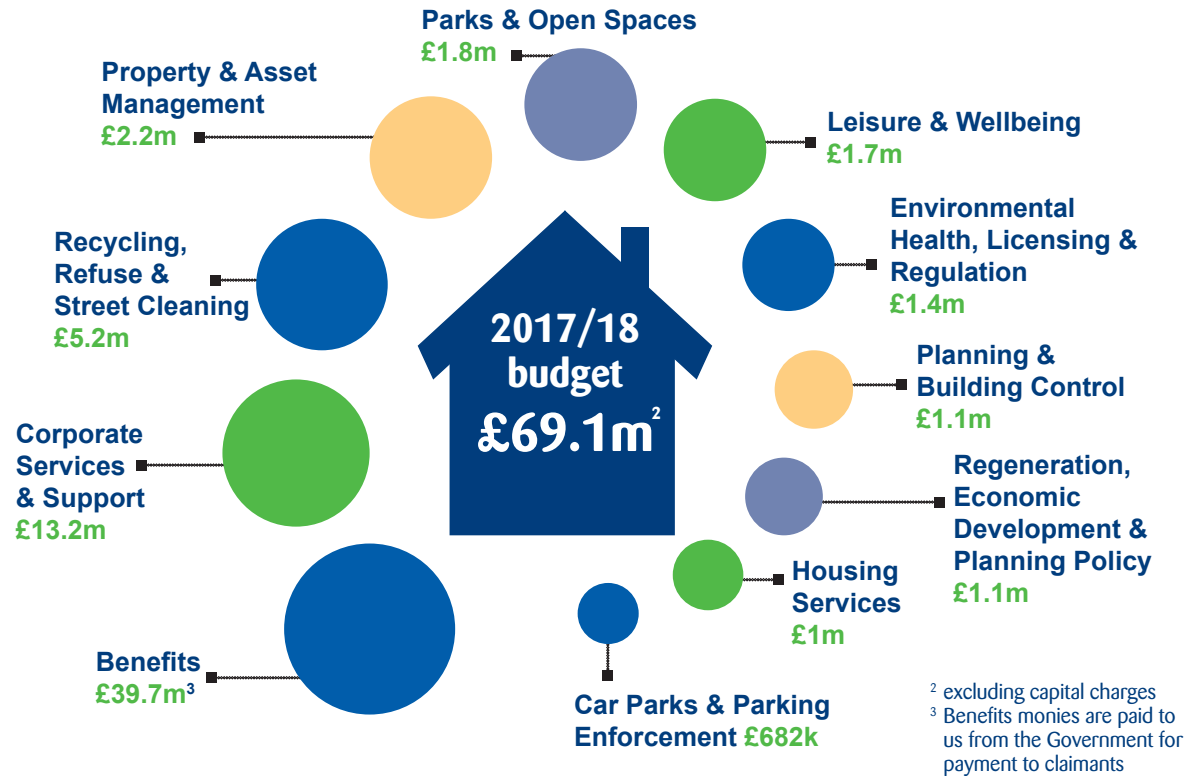
