- From Monday 5 October to Friday 13 November 2020 inclusive, any interested person may, on application to the address below, inspect the accounts of the Council for the year ended 2019-20 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts). They may also make copies of the accounts and documents. Application should be made to the Interim Head of Finance at the address below. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic Council Offices are not currently open to the public so special arrangements will need to be considered on request.
- From 10am on Monday 5 October 2020 until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector for the area of the Council, or their representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.
- 3. From 10am on Monday 5 October 2020 until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector for the area of the Council, or their representative, may object to the Council's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Audit Commission Act 1998) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address below.
