## **Council Tax 2023 to 2024**

### How your Council Tax helps to fund Reigate & Banstead's services

For all of the services Reigate & Banstead Borough Council provides, a typical household pays £249.71 a year. That's about £4.80 a week - about 14p more than last year¹. While we collect your Council Tax, just 11 pence in each pound comes to us to help deliver over 50 services to our 151,000 residents and 7,055 businesses.

This year's budget focuses on **people**, **services and financial self-sufficiency**, prioritising the services our communities need, alongside investing in future opportunities. It's a difficult time for everyone, including councils – with the economic slowdown and significant inflation. We've also received no core funding from

central government since 2017. We've managed these challenges proactively, taking into account what it means for residents, businesses and partners.

We've worked hard to make the most of our resources, but once again we've had to make some tough budget decisions to make sure local people, places and our economy continue to thrive. This includes increasing some budgets and reducing others by making savings or increasing income from some fees and charges as well as services like our Harlequin Theatre & Cinema. Income is reinvested to support the delivery of our services, including ringfencing £150,000 from our share of Council Tax to help residents who may need extra support with the cost of living.

We will continue to work hard to maintain our strong financial position and deliver our five year plan, Reigate & Banstead 2025, to benefit everyone who lives in or does business in our borough.




